We receive many requests for trips to venues, where we would be unlikely to be able to fill a coach. So, for 2022 we are combining a number of days trips in order that we can fulfill some of those requests.



For example, why not join us as we visit the stunning Exbury Gardens world-famous collection of rhododendrons and azalea and steam railway, or maybe you would prefer to visit Beaulieu with its National Motor Museum and exhibitions, Palace House, Abbey and gardens. The choice is yours!

**SILVERSTONE EXPERIENCE**

Until recently, Silverstone had no one to tell its wonderful story. Now, however, the detailed history of the UK's premier circuit can be followed at The Silverstone Experience, a huge interactive museum near the circuit's main entrance.

Discover Silverstone's past including its time as a Command Training base for Wellington bomber pilots during WW2. When racing began in 1948, this venerable structure did at least provide the names of Hangar Straight and Wellington Straight, and still does.

operating a wind tunnel to taking part in a pit stop to climbing into a replica Grand Prix car, you can't fail to be impressed.

Exit from the museum via the most awe-inspiring interactive feature of all, a spectacular theatre experience during which you're enveloped by a huge video wall that curves away to your sides and up over your head. Sit in a notional racing car and circulate, at racing speeds, while great Silverstone moments happen all around you. In one helping, this is a huge slice of Silverstone's August racing history.

The glorious 70-year racing history of Silverstone is covered from start to finish once you walk down the stairs to the expansive ground floor. With over 60 hands-on exhibits giving visitors the opportunity to try a variety of activities, from

## Easter in 'MAGICAL MANX'

Described as a 'Jewel in the Irish Sea', the Isle of Man, (IOM) also known simply as Mann, is a magical and enchanting island, full of charm and surprises.

Beautiful scenery in the lush valleys, barren hills and rugged coastlines combined with a wealth of historic castles and buildings. In 2016 Unesco designated the IOM a biosphere reserve (one of only 5 in the UK) marking it as one of the most beautiful spots in Britain to enjoy nature.

During our five day (four night) stay we will take you to Castletown to visit one of the best preserved medieval castles in the world, before visiting Port Erin and heading back to the hotel on board the steam train.

You have a day at leisure in Douglas where you could take a stroll along the prom or maybe a trip on a horse-drawn tram or visit the Manx Museum with its treasure trove of island artefacts and then head out along Marine drive to enjoy the panoramic views.

The following day we head out on the electric railway to visit the laxey Wheel, the biggest surviving waterwheel in the world before heading up to see the breathtaking views on Snaefell's summit.

Our final day is one of leisure or if you prefer you could join us for an optional trip around the island for a lap of the TT course, pay a visit to the Tynwald Exhibition and finally Moore's Kipper Yard for a taste of the famous Manx kippers!



## The ISLE OF WIGHT

Whilst we often run a day trip to the Island, we've had many requests for a longer stay, so for 2022 we are offering a five day (four night) break at the Broadway Park Hotel in Sandown for £385.

During our stay we will be visiting attractions such as Osborne House, Queen Victoria's palatial holiday home, taking a trip on the beautifully preserved award-winning railway Isle of Wight Steam Railway and additionally heading to some of the award winning coves and sandy beaches.

## Heading east to Norfolk



As with the Isle of Wight, whilst we run day trips to the Norfolk area, our time is always limited so we have decided to make this a base for one of our holidays for 2022.



We stay at the Best Western Brook Hotel in Norwich for four nights and during our stay, plan to take a trip on the Bure Valley Steam Railway, Norfolk's longest narrow gauge railway, a cruise on the Southern Comfort



Paddle steamer and pay a visit to the Queen's country retreat at Sandringham.

We also head out to Cromer where we'll be sure to sample the world famous crab and then have time at leisure to visit Norwich and Lings Lynn. Full details will be in the forthcoming 2022 brochure.

## BIDEFORD, DEVON £330 PER PERSON

We head to North Devon for a five day (four night) break at the Durrant House Hotel in the historic market town of Bideford, which was once Britain's third largest port.

During our stay we will be visiting some of the neighbouring towns in addition to a number of the seaside resorts such as Lynton and Lynmouth, with its charming old town and Ilfracombe, a pretty seaside town, seafront and small harbour surrounded by dramatic cliffs.

A deposit of £50 per person is required to secure your place. Deposits paid are non-refundable and non-transferable except where arrangements are cancelled by Mullanys Coaches.

## LONGLEAT SKY SAFARI



## THE CUCKOO FAIR or Salisbury




It's time to cavort around the maypole, morris dance and of course, crown the Cuckoo Princess. Or, you can spend the day in the city of Salisbury.
